For assessment purposes, there were six obligatory assignments. If a student failed an assignment, there was a separate 'retake assignment' on the same topic.

### Sammendrag av studentene sin evaluering / Summarize the results from the student evaluation

We have received evaluation from seven students. Overall, the results are quite positive, scoring above 5 in many categories. One of the students, however, was dissatisfied with their seminar leader and marked the course very low, which impacted the averages. In particular, averages for lectures and course overall are high (above 5), and averages for seminars are lower.

In particular, everyone, apart from one student, seem to have had positive experience with the course. Comments include: 'Very interesting and important course.' and 'My favourite course this semester. I've had a lot of fun with it.'.

The only negative comment I give here in full:

I felt discouraged from turning in assignments, as i felt the person grading them was unnecessarily rude. He seemed to have no understanding for why a question might be answered wrong. Instead of getting a suggestion as to how i should have answered, so that it would be correct, i got feedback essentially telling me I was stupid for not understanding.

Overall, I think that the course was a success. TA's did a great job. Students were active during the lectures and asked questions, and seemed generally interested in the topic.
