Parts 1 and 2 count for 25 percent each in the exam assessment. Part 3 is 50 percent

The exam can be group-based or individual. The group-based exam has two models you can choose between. You can complete all three parts as groups. Or you can complete parts 1 and 2 as a group and part 3 as an individual task.

I was not the sensor for most of the submissions as the students could deliver in Norwegian and I could only grade the ones delivered in English (only 1). However, I could see the grades given by the other sensors and it seems that they were in line with my diagnostic evaluations of the students throughout the semester. The grades of the students' oral presentations mainly fall within the range of B. Given the amount of practice and supervision we had throughout the course of this subject, this was an expected result.
