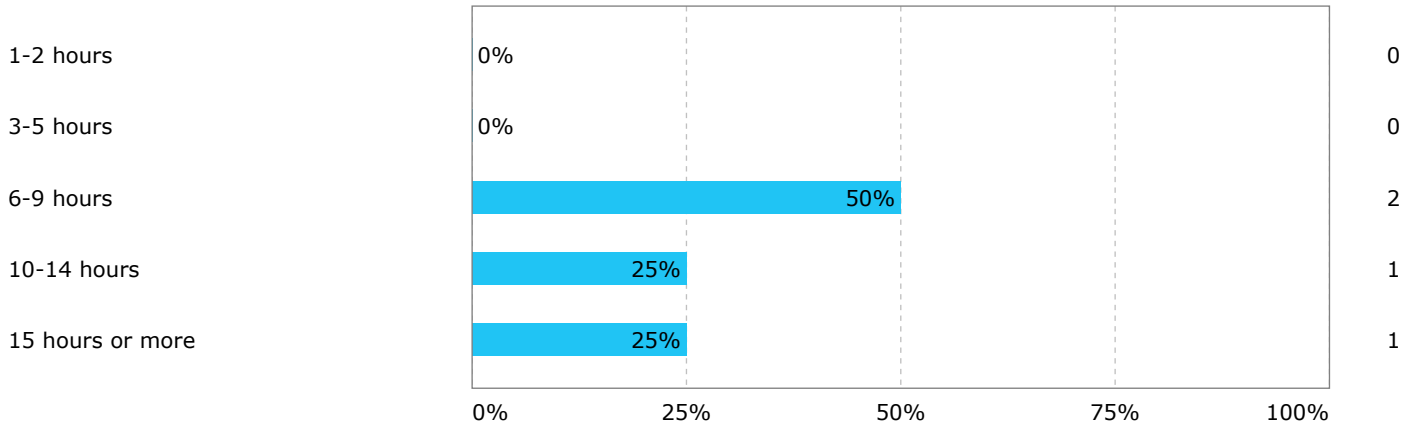

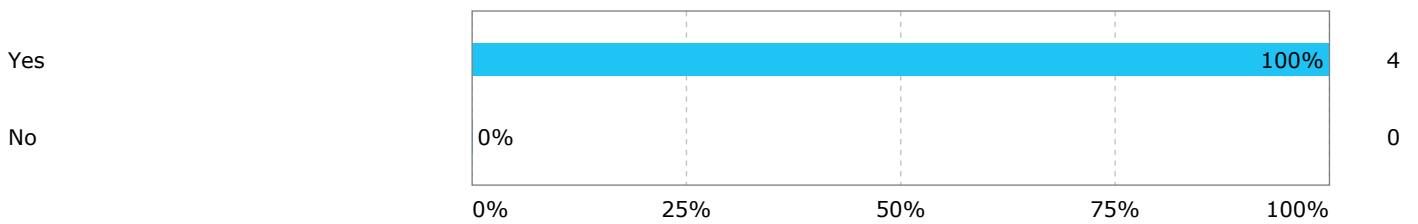
How many hours weekly have you spent on the course in total (lecture, own-studies, reading groups, etc.)



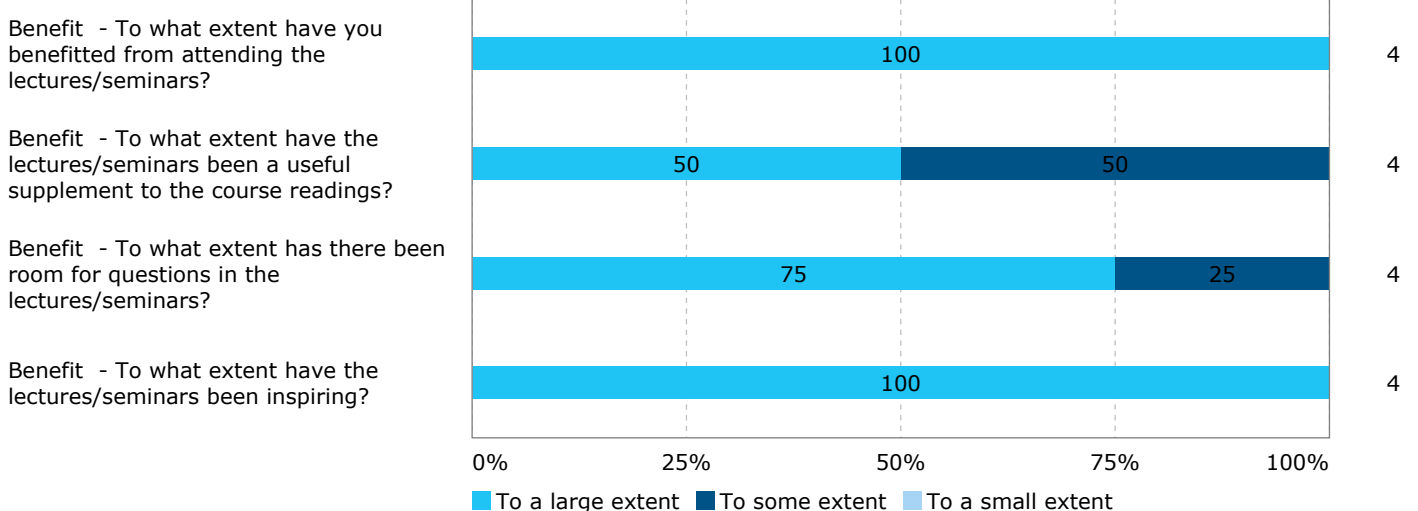
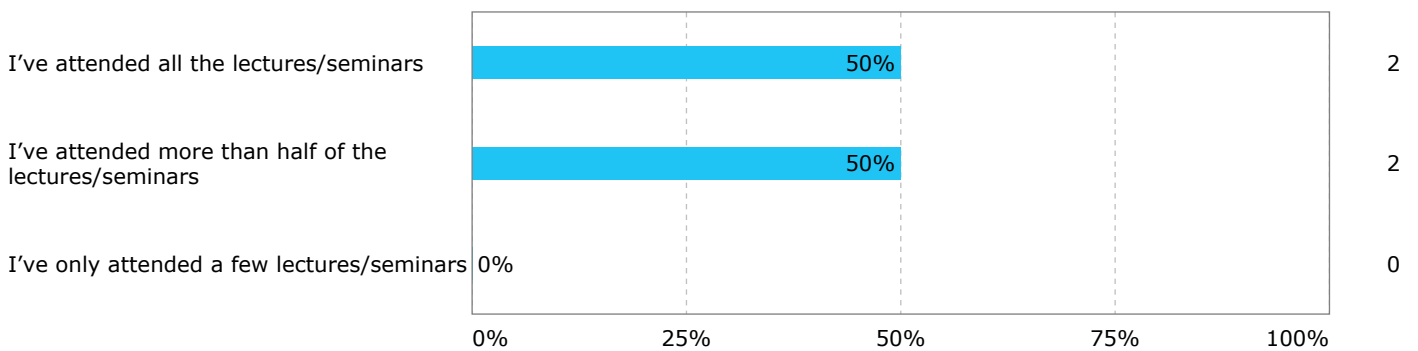
### How do you consider the workload relative to the number of credits?



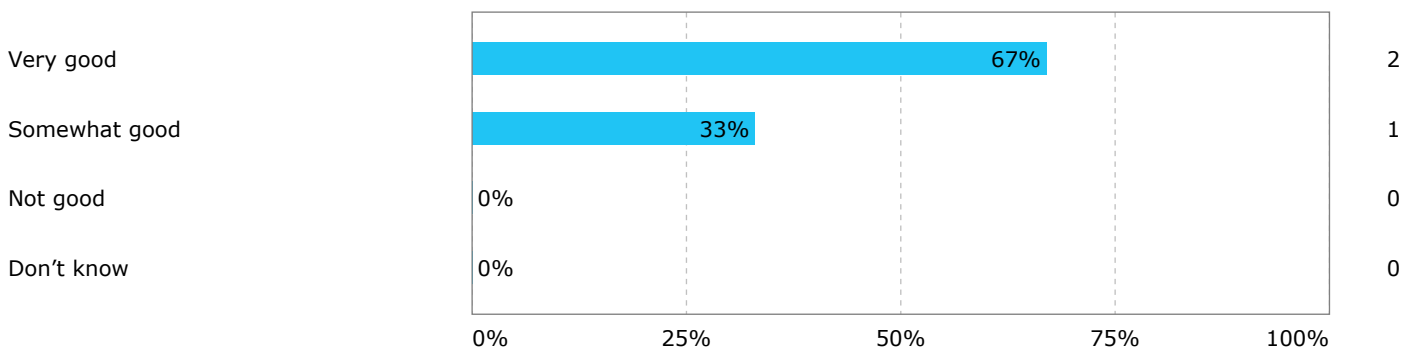

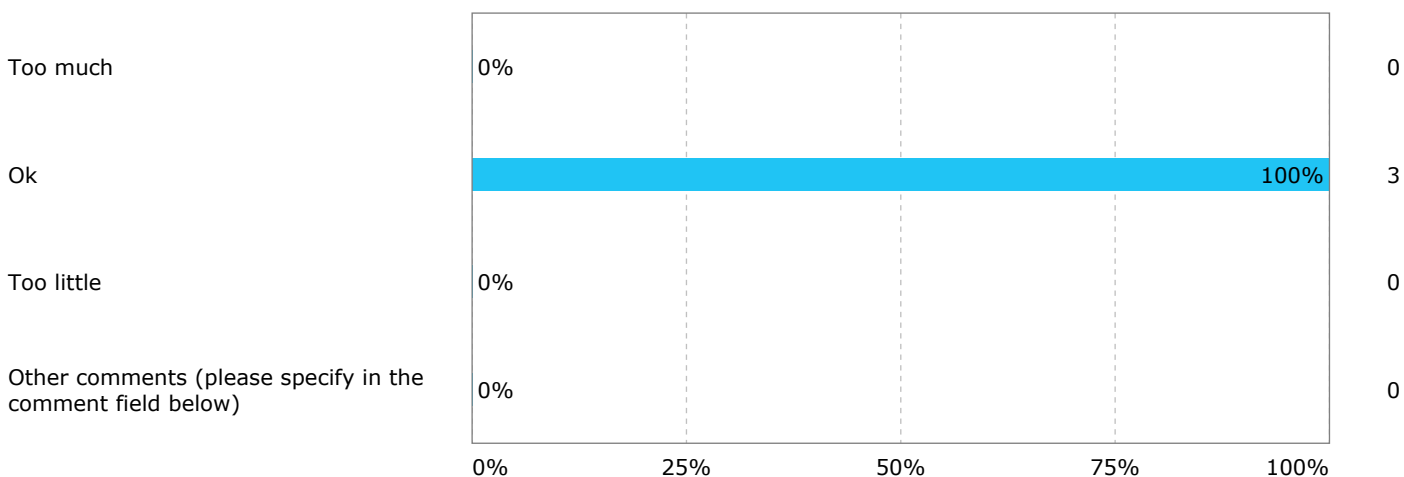

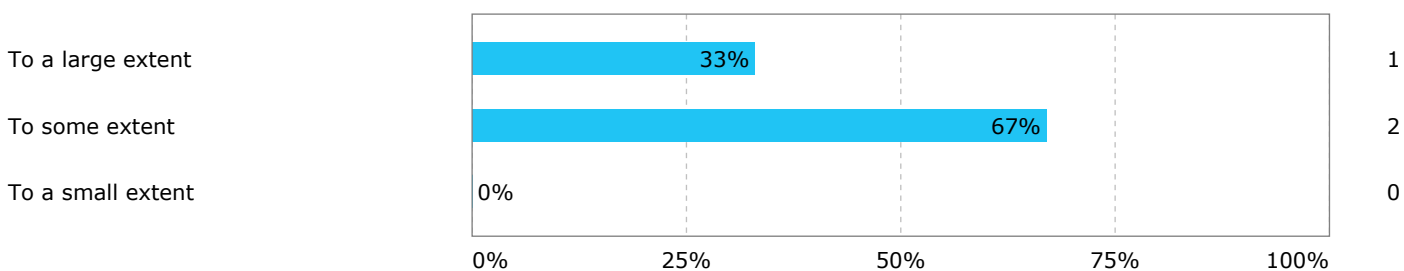

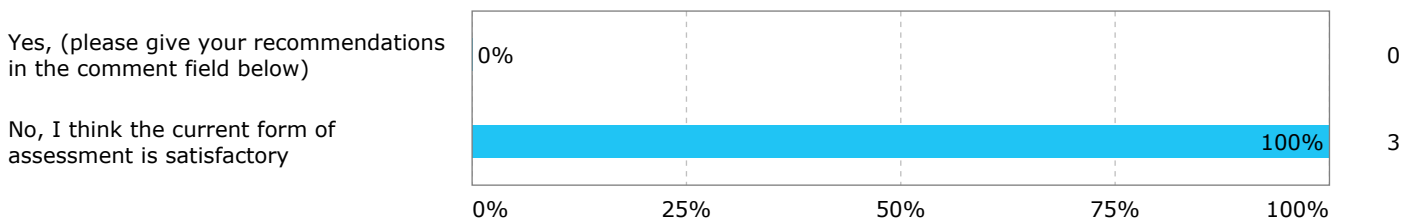

For those attending the virtue ethics student conference: What did you think of it as part of the course?

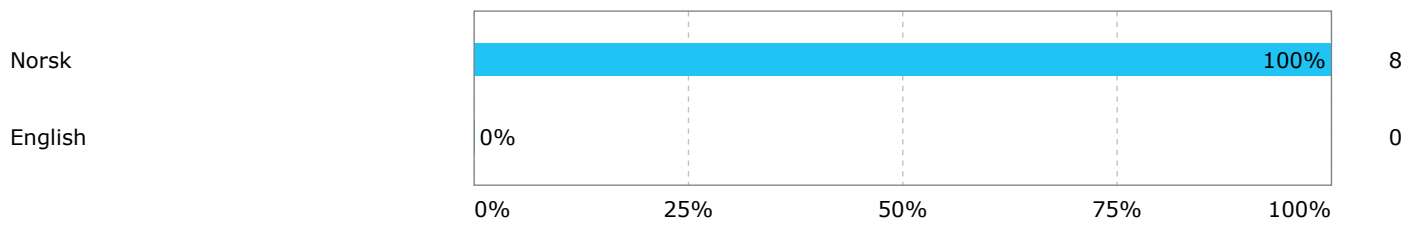
